Audit Report

Alipurduar Mahila Mahavidyalaya was founded in 2007 in response to the need in the Alipurduar district for a college specifically for girls.

In the past sixteen years, the College has advanced significantly. Despite being a female-only college, it does not limit its students to academics. Rather, every effort has been and continues to be made to give its pupils every chance to realize their potential and demonstrate their value to their families, the community, and themselves.

Here, the College's NSS unit deserves special recognition for its vital role in inspiring the girls to take on their social obligations. The NSS Unit periodically organizes outreach initiatives, awareness campaigns, and special camps. Through the various Add-On Courses the college has adopted, girls are also trained in Karate, Self-Defense Techniques, and Different Dance Forms. Special Lectures on Gender Issues and Legal Awareness Programmes are also organised keeping in mind benefit of the students. Talks on Mental Health Issues are organised in collaboration with NGO. Incase any girl is identified having any mental health issue, she is referred to the NGO for professional help.

The Grievance Redressal Cell looks into the grievances of the students, if any and as and when reported. The Cell meets quarterly to discuss the issues of the students.


The Internal Complaints Committee has been formed following the POSH Act, 2013. The Committee has not received any complaint till date.

The Add – On Course in Life Skill Training provides training in Karate as a self – defense technique. The Course was introduced to ensure that girls are self – sufficient and capable of protecting themselves.


