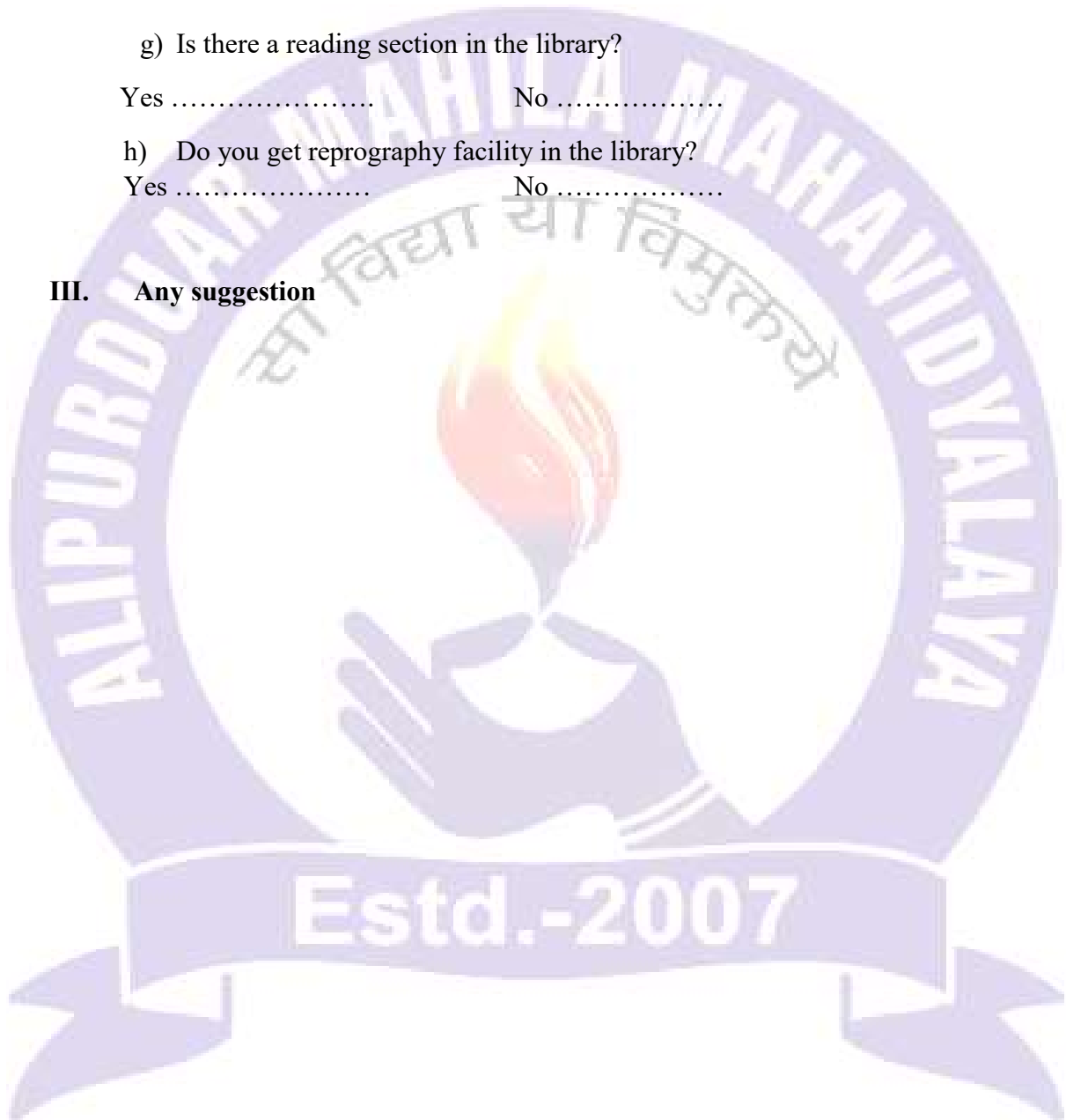

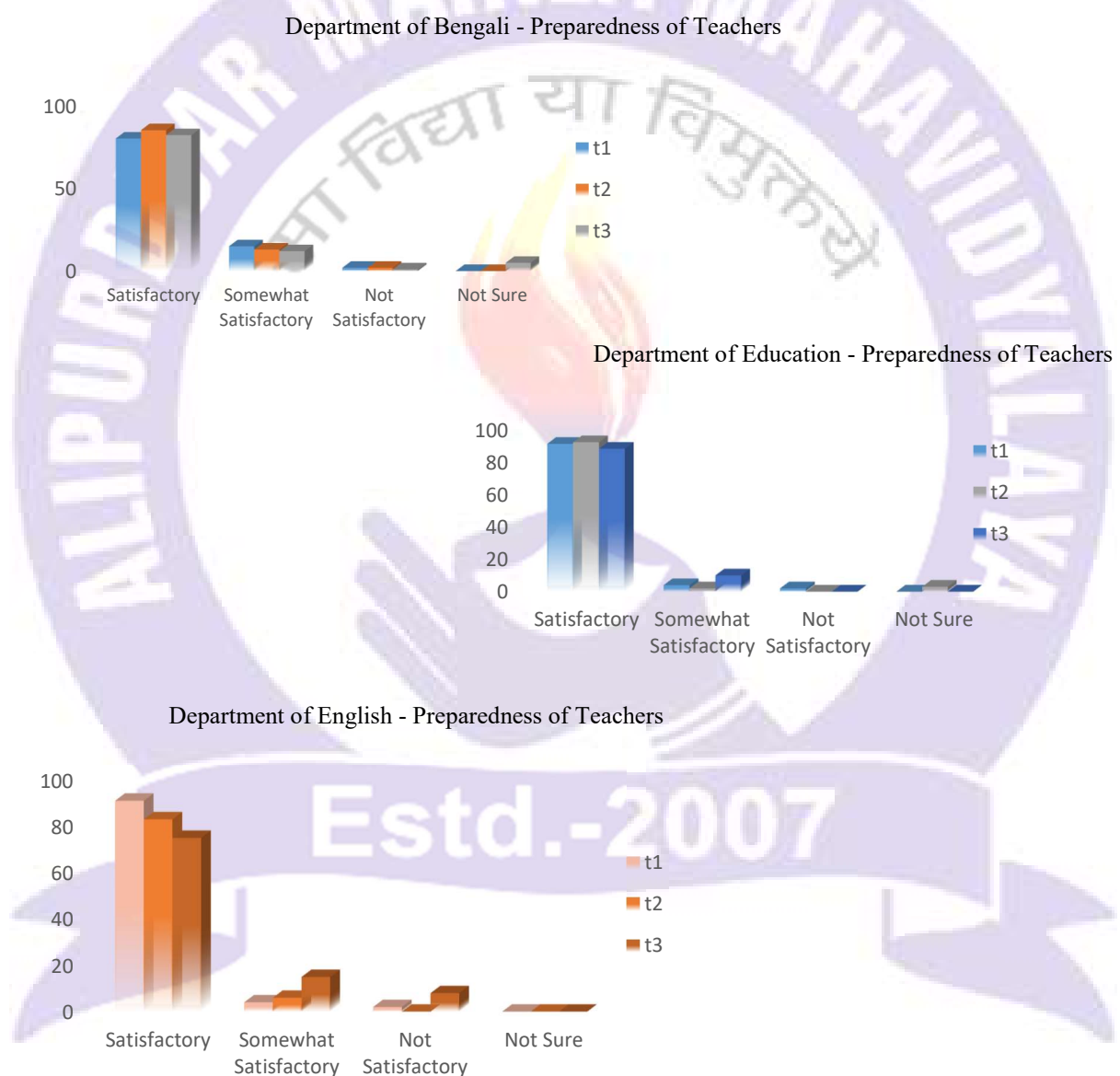
Result of the Student Satisfaction Survey (Session 2022 – 23)

The survey sheet was administered in the online mode (as Google Form). The responses were recorded. In order to ensure anonymity, students were told not to mention their names and put their responses freely.

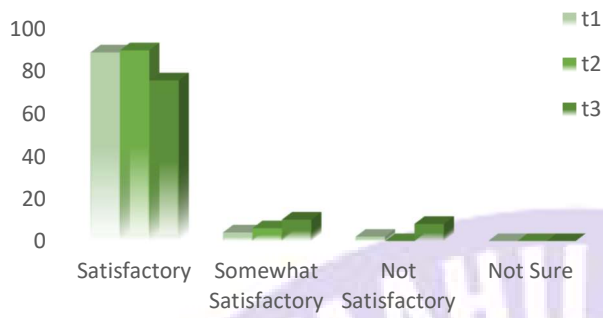

PREPAREDNESS OF THE TEACHERS FOR CLASS



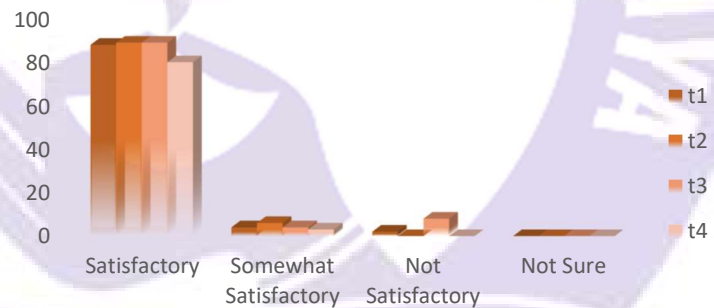
Department of History - Preparedness of Teachers



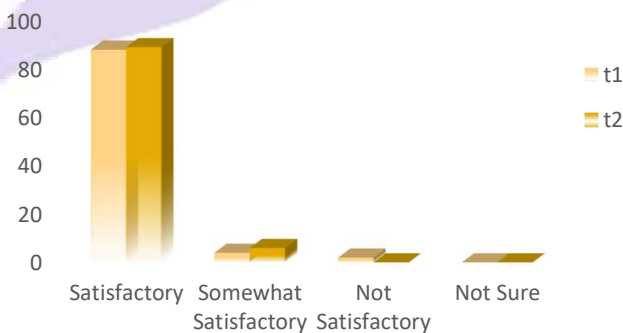
Department of Philosophy – Preparedness of Teacher

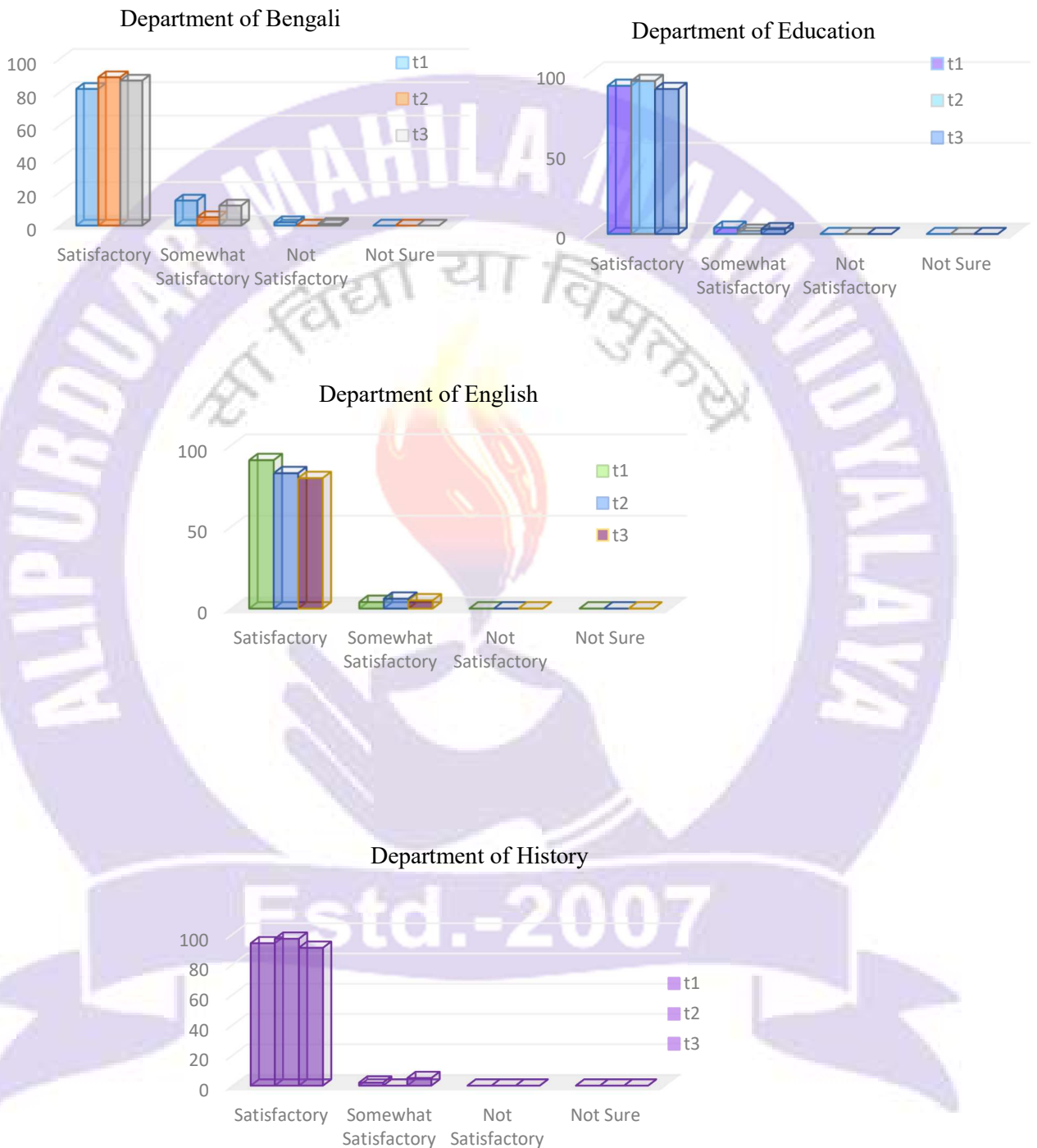

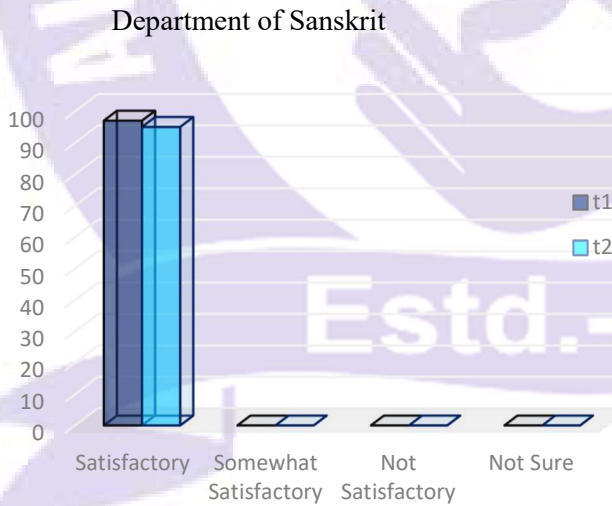
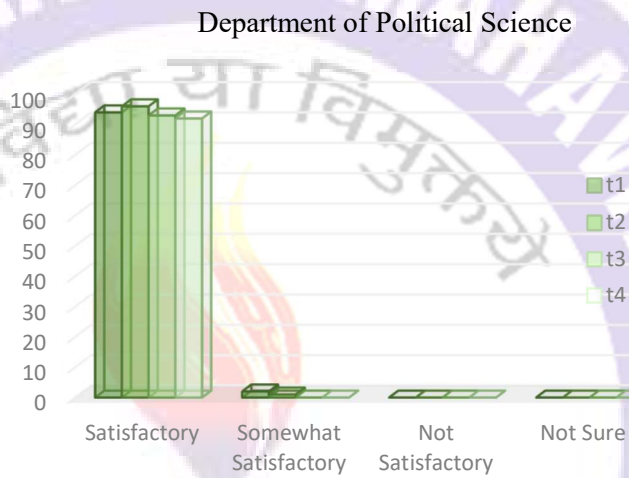


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Regarding completion of syllabus, all the students uniformly responded that syllabus was completed by all the teachers well within time. Not a single teacher left their syllabus incomplete.

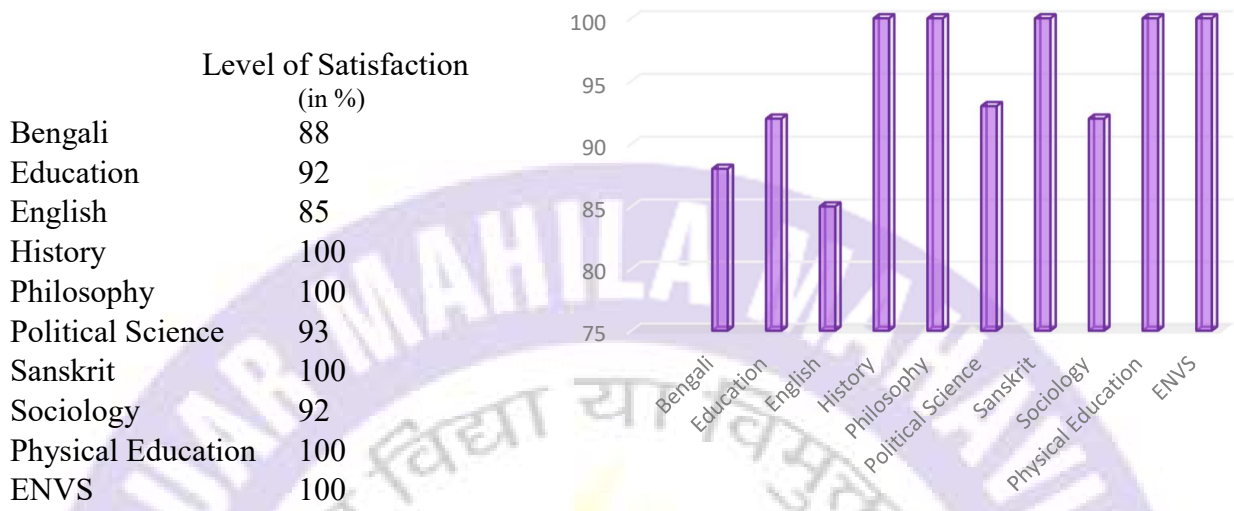
METHOD OF TEACHING



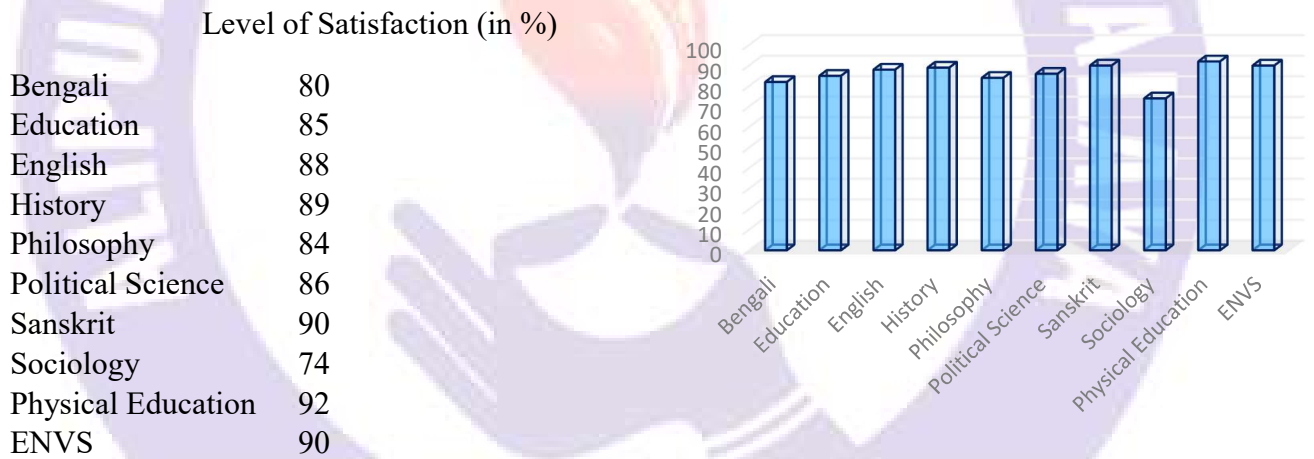


The symbols t_1 , t_2 , t_3 and t_4 represent the teachers in each Department.

INTERACTION IN CLASS

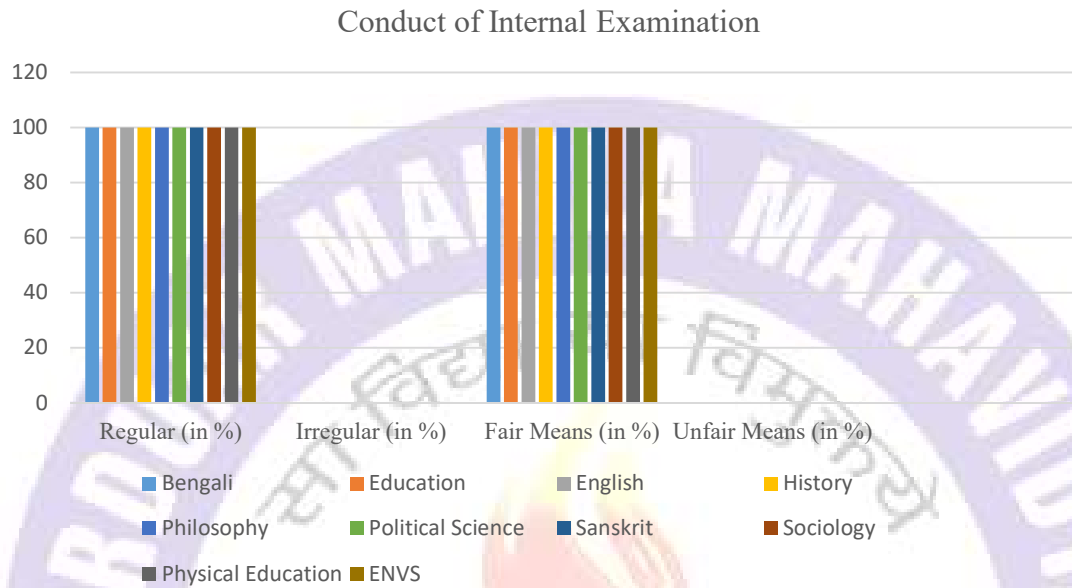


USAGE OF AUDIO – VISUAL AIDS

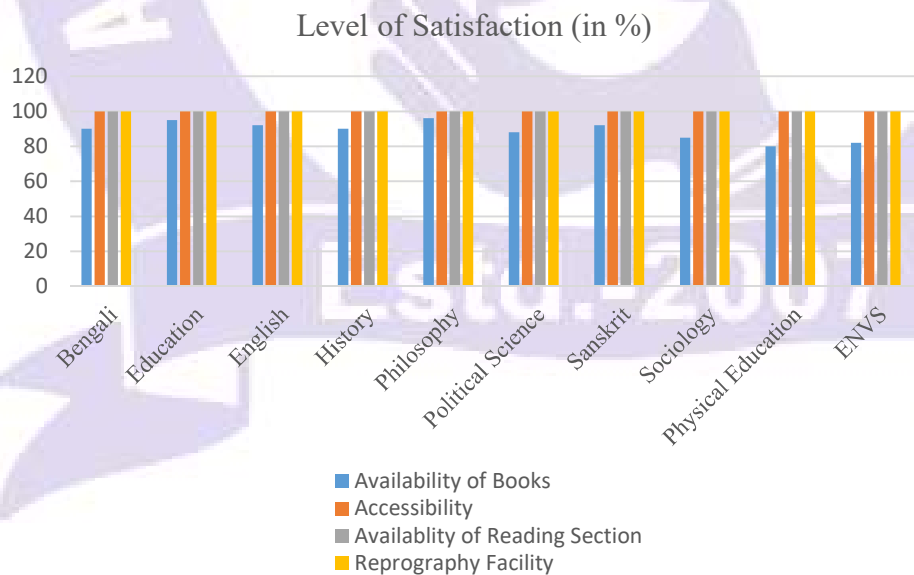


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CONDUCT OF INTERNAL EXAMINATION

QUALITATIVE ANALYSIS

Nearly majority of the students in each Department stated that they got along well with their teachers. Teachers were friendly and always available to offer advice when needed. In fact, teachers were very important in assisting them in identifying their strengths and flaws. They provided the support students needed to improve their skills and overcome their weaknesses. Some of the teachers served as their mentors and assisted them in coping with their problems.

Students reported that the fair continuous evaluation procedure benefited them in their examination preparation and provided them with a better understanding of their subject matter.

Majority of students felt that participating in extracurricular activities improved their character. They acquired values related to collaboration and sharing. Sincerity and humility were established in them as a result of their participation in NSS activities. By taking part in cultural events, they learned about the variety of regional traditions and customs.

Attending Special Lectures on Gender Equity, Intellectual Property Rights, Career Awareness Programmes and other Social Issues made them better human beings. These lectures raised their social consciousness and made them more socially aware. They learned more about the changing workplace environment.

Some students experienced difficulties with the library, primarily because they couldn't find books in the Bengali language and found it challenging to follow the English books. However, their teachers did assist them in translating study materials.

An overall analysis shows that students were quite satisfied with their Institution.
