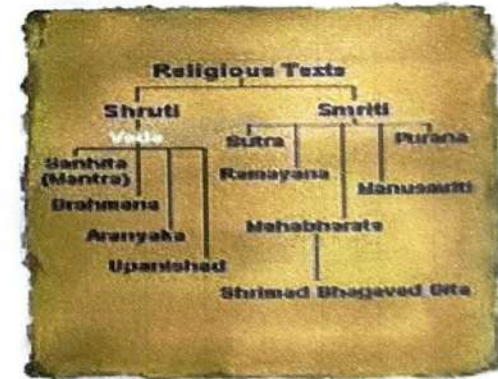
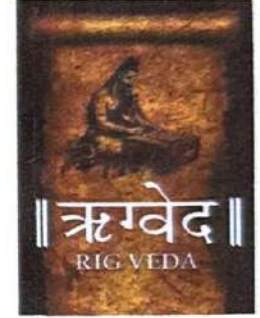

Panel Discussion on 'An Insight into the Indian Knowledge System from the Vedic Aspect'

Date: 13/03/2024

The Indian Knowledge System integrates extracurricular activities, athletics, and the arts into the curriculum with a heavy emphasis on holistic development. Through this combination, students are certain to develop a skill set that goes beyond academic brilliance.

The panel discussion highlighted the significance of Knowledge System in ancient India and how it has evolved over the years. 18 major vidyas, or theoretical disciplines, and 64 kalas, or applied or vocational disciplines, or crafts, are mentioned in tradition. The four Vedas, the four subsidiary Vedas (Ayurveda for medicine, Dhanurveda for weapons, Gandharvaveda for music, and Silpa for architecture), the Purana, Nyaya, Mimamsa, Dharmasastra, and Vedanga, the six auxiliary sciences (phonetics, grammar, metre, astronomy, ritual, and philology) and the eighteen sciences (dharmasastra) comprise the eighteen vidyas. All these vidyas are responsible in shaping the education system as it is today.
