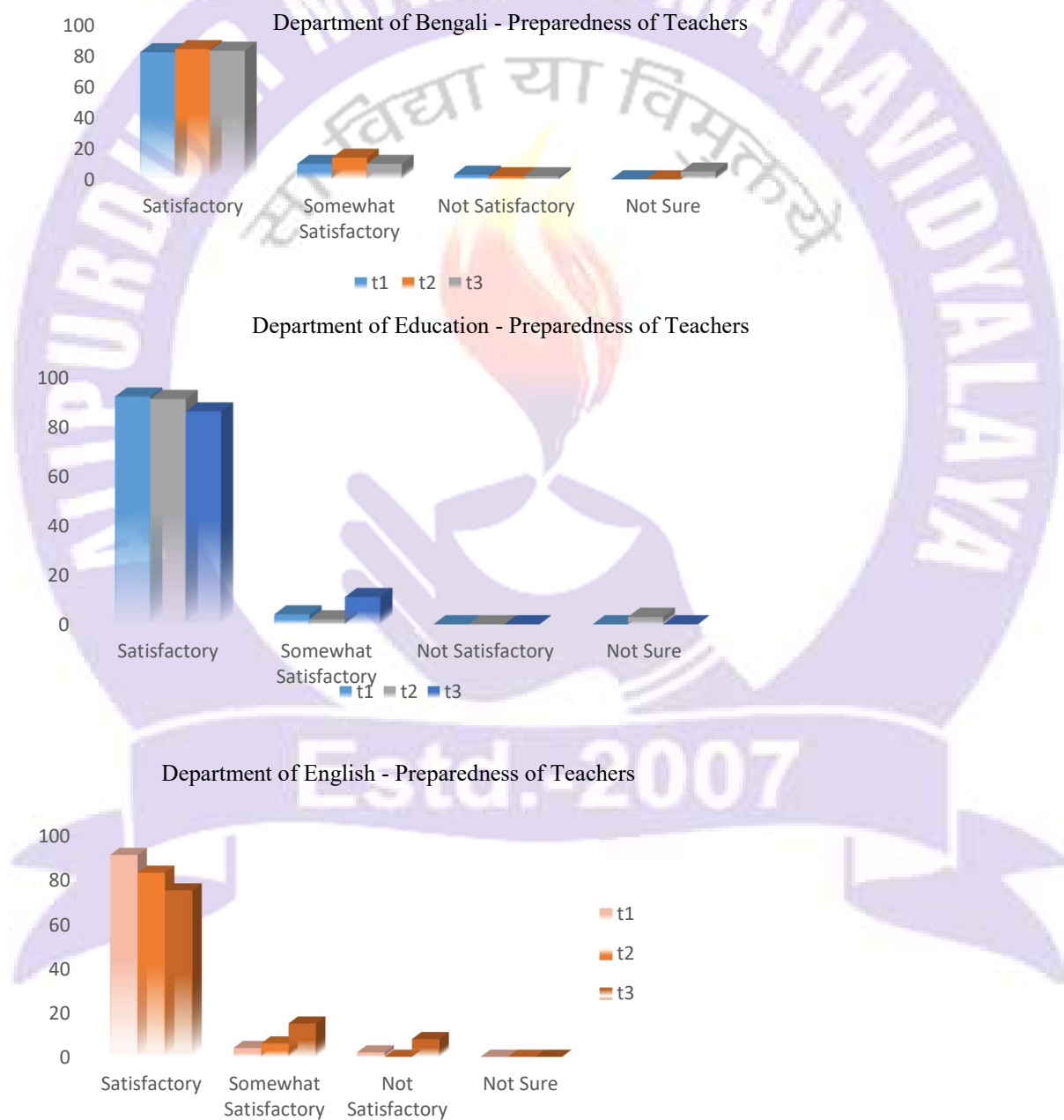
Result of the Student Satisfaction Survey (Session 2023 – 24)

PREPAREDNESS OF THE TEACHERS FOR CLASS



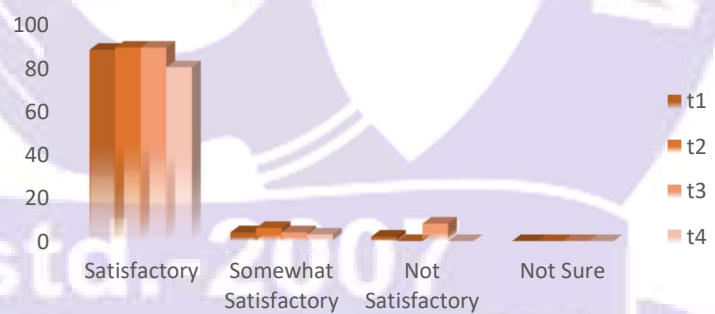
Department of History - Preparedness of Teachers

Department of Political Science – Preparedness of Teachers



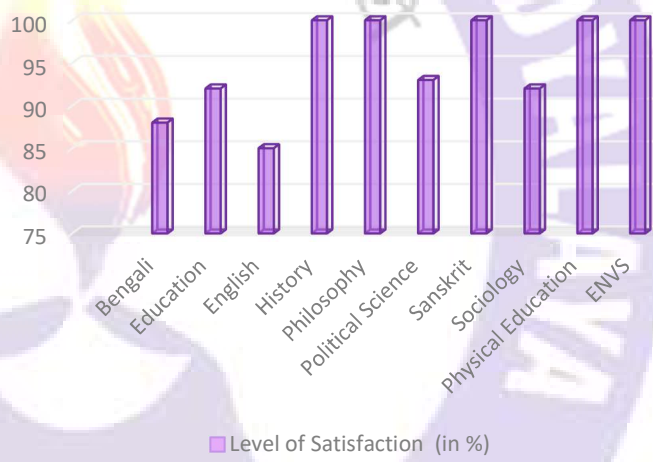
Department of Sanskrit – Preparedness of Teachers

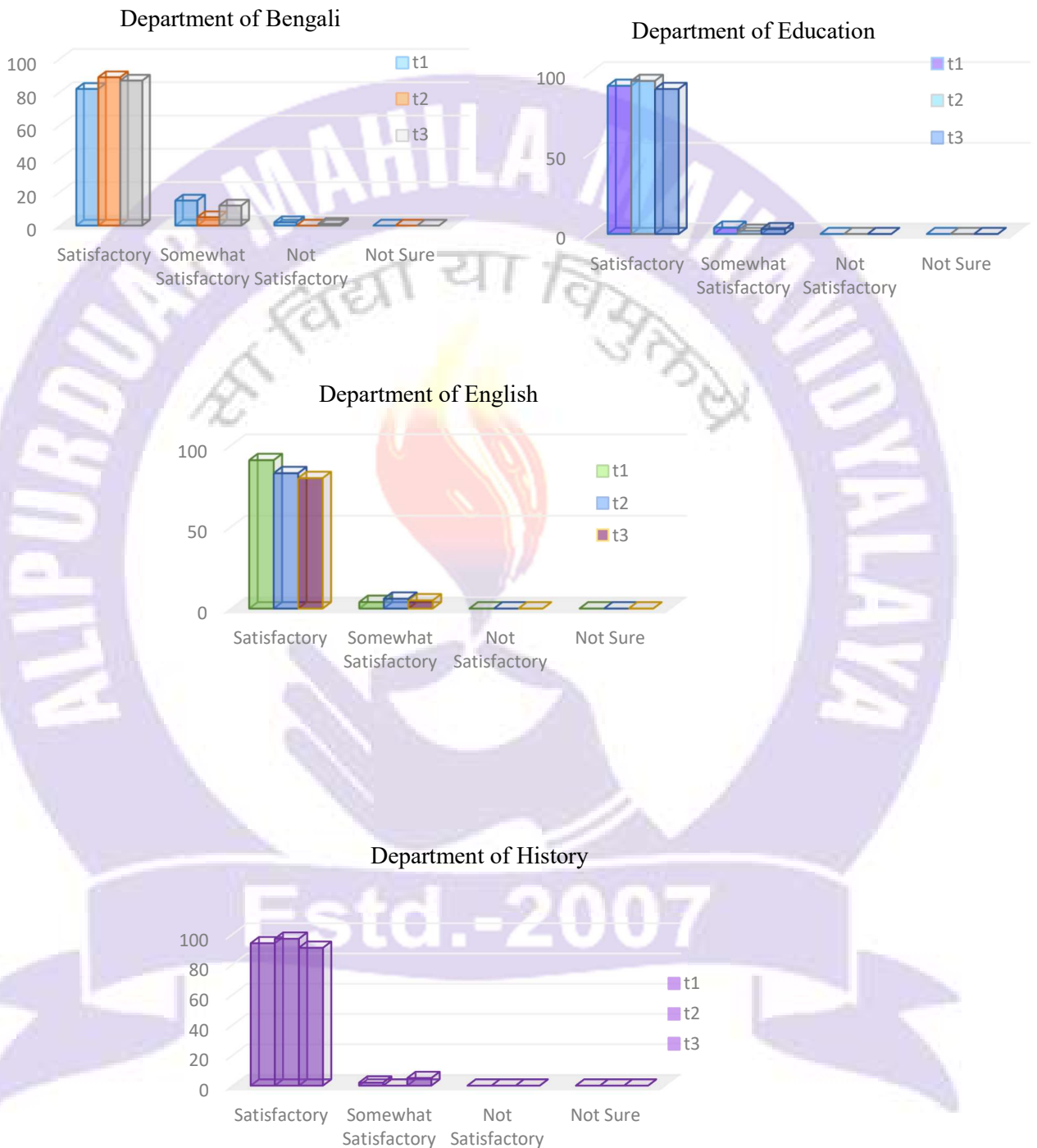

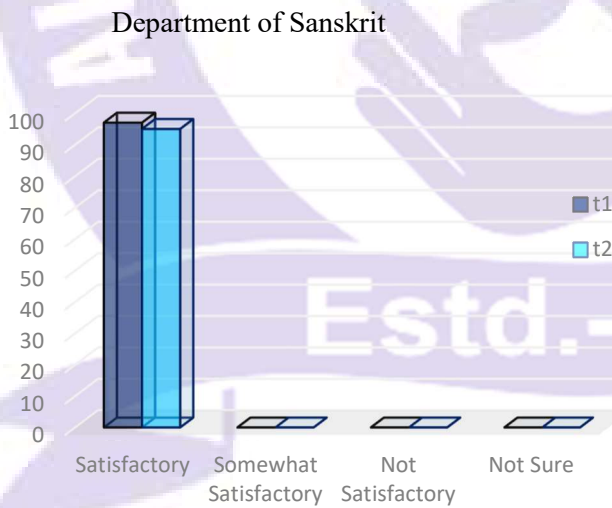
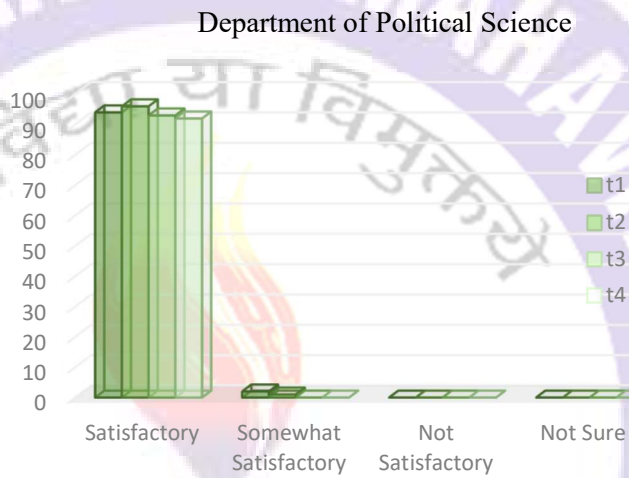

Regarding the completion of the curriculum, every student consistently replied that all teachers had finished it on time. Not a single teacher neglected to complete their syllabus.

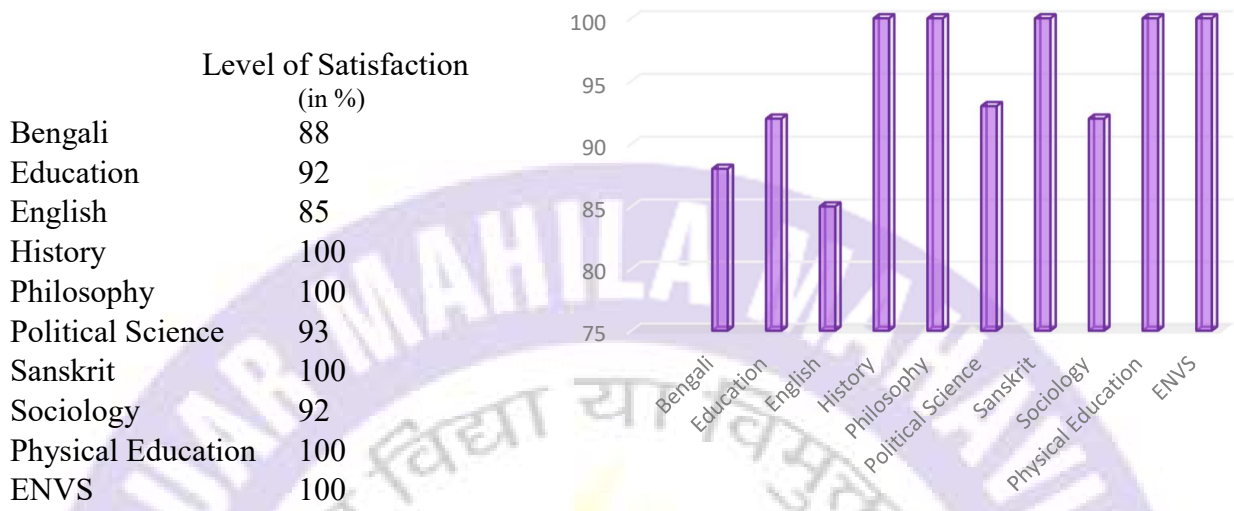
METHOD OF TEACHING



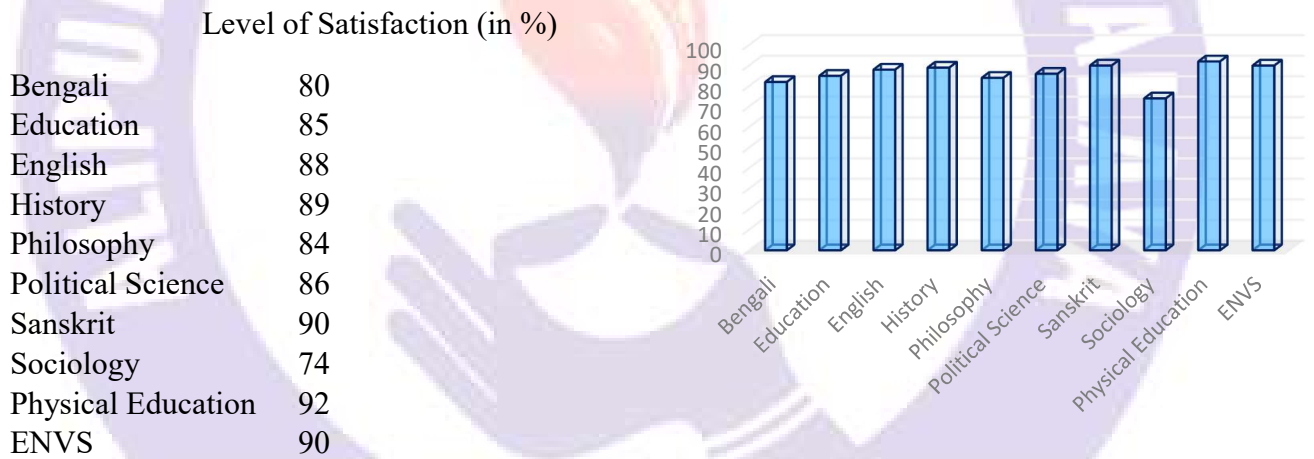


The symbols t_1 , t_2 , t_3 and t_4 represent the teachers in each Department.

INTERACTION IN CLASS

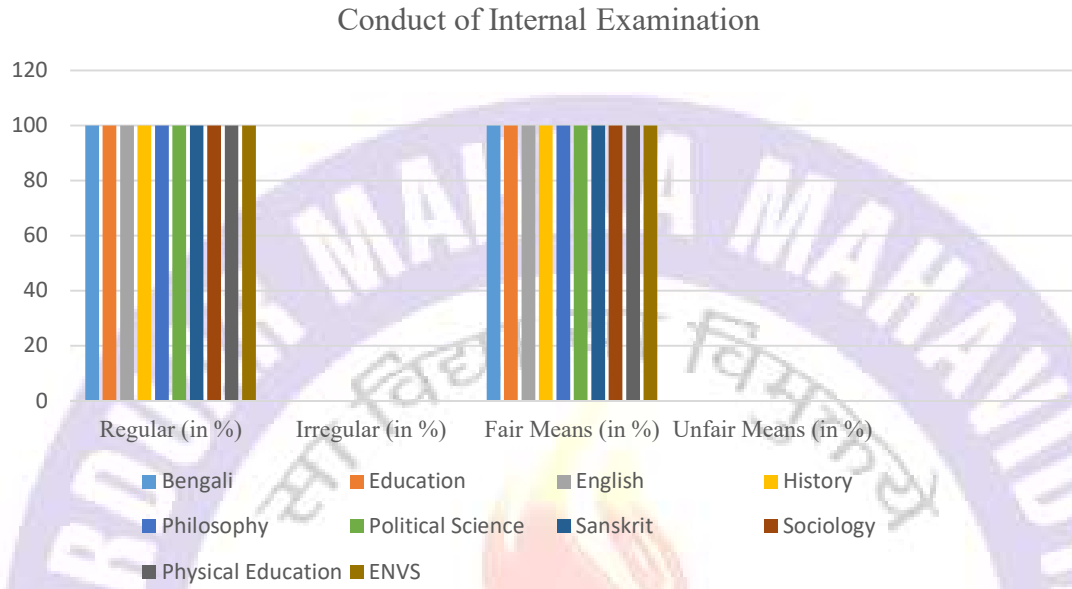


USAGE OF AUDIO – VISUAL AIDS

QUALITATIVE ANALYSIS

According to the majority of students in each department, they had good relationship with their teachers. The teachers were amiable and always willing to give guidance. In actuality, teachers played a crucial role in helping pupils recognize their advantages and disadvantages. They gave students the assistance they required to strengthen their areas of strength and weakness. Some of the teachers helped them deal with their issues and acted as mentors to them. Students said they had a better grasp of their subject matter and were better prepared for exams thanks to the fair continuous evaluation process.

Majority of the students believed that participation in extracurricular activities helped in character building. They picked up ideals of sharing and working together. They developed humility and sincerity as a result of their involvement in NSS programs. They gained knowledge of the diversity of local traditions and customs by participating in cultural activities. They became better prepared as a result of attending special lectures on topics such as career awareness programs, intellectual property rights, gender equity, and other social issues. They became more socially concerned and aware as a result of these lectures. They gained greater knowledge about how the workplace is evolving.

Students acknowledged that the number of books in the library has been increased. Books are now available in both English and Bengali addressing their need. Teachers also put in their best effort to help students in using the open access system and completing library work.

An overall analysis shows that students were quite satisfied with their Institution.
